Applications will be accepted through April 15, 2024. Judges will read and score the applications and determine a winner of the Integrity Award for each Livingston Parish High School.

Selected winners at each high school will receive a check for \$250 or more based on available scholarship funds and a Certificate of Integrity. It is possible that runners-up will also be awarded certificates of recognition as per recommendations from the judges.

Presentation of the Integrity Award can be scheduled for the Senior Scholarship Awards Programs at each school. It will be appreciated if each school will notify Integrity Insurance of the dates/times of the awards programs. We do not know at this time if a representative will be available to present the award, but we'd like the option as the time draws near. Again, the Integrity Award Presentation Package will include the Certificate of Integrity and a \$250 check.
