Amount:

Eligibility:

Any female student who is a U.S. citizen or legal U.S. resident. The student must be a Public Relations, Communications, Media Studies, Marketing, or Journalism major with a desire to work in the entertainment or sports industry. Must be enrolled at a four-year accredited university, have a minimum 2.75 GPA, and demonstrate financial need.

Instructions:

Complete the application and submit all required documents by email or traditional mail.

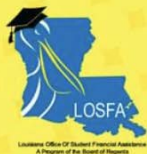
Eligibility:

Eligibility:

Must demonstrate a need for financial support. One of the student's parents must be of Hispanic ancestry.
